PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Staff, Students, Parents, Carers and Community Members,

This week, I have been on Long Service Leave in Brisbane watching my son at State Baseball (I wrote this whilst enjoying the sun and being a Mum). I want to thank Mr Anderson (A/ Principal) and Mrs Lanskey (A/DP) who manned the fort during my time away. I am looking forward to seeing kids and families on Tuesday.

Part of my daily routine is walking through classrooms and seeing student engagement and work samples of progress. I am so impressed by the work happening in all grades and students trying their best and having a go.

As part of ongoing school improvement, the education leaders are completing Instructional Leadership Walkthroughs (ILWs) in all classrooms. ILWs are informal classroom interactions for short durations, routinely undertaken to gain a line of sight over student engagement and learning, as well as a sense of key aspects of school culture.

When we go into classrooms, we are using 5 Key Questions to ask students:

- 1. What are you learning?
- 2. How are you doing?
- 3. How do you know?
- 4. How can you improve?
- 5. Where do you go for help?









PRINCIPAL'S REPORT continued...

Gathering this information helps us to understand how our students are learning and their learning progress. As education leaders we are then looking at ways to continue student progress and reach our goals of every student at Tolga SS achieving individual 12 month growth in 12 months.

Next week we will be hosting our Parent Interviews on Tuesday, 9th September in the school library. Teachers will have got in contact with classes already to organise meeting times. If you have not made a time and wish to do so, please contact class teachers to ensure you can have these discussions regarding your student's progress at school. Hope to see you there!





STEP 2. IF NOT RESOLVED -CONTACT THE SCHOOL OFFICE

Email the office at admin@tolgass.eq.edu.au and your request will be forwarded to the correct staff member for follow up and resolution.

STUDENT ABSENCE PROCEDURES

At Tolga school we expect all students to attend school on all school days. **Every day at school does count.** Parents or guardians of students who are absent must inform the school of their student's absences. Parents/Caregivers will be sent a text message if the student's absence is unexplained.

You can reply to the text message. If a reason for the student's absence is not provided, this is assigned the Absence Reason Code of U – Unexplained and will be recorded on the student's attendance and report card.

If your child is absent from school:-

- · Phone the School Absence Line 4089 5166 and leave a message or
- · Advise the absence via QParents or
- · Reply to text message when received or
- · Phone school office 4089 5111

Note: Parents need to apply for an exemption if their child/ren will be away for more than 10 consecutive school days. This application form is available for collection from the school office and needs to be approved by the Principal.

If your child is leaving school early:

- · Phone the school office 4089 5111 to advise reason and time of collection from the office or
- · Send a note with your child to the office with the reason and time of departure

Note: Your child will be present at the office at the prearranged time for collection. Your child <u>must</u> be sighted and signed out before leaving school grounds.

If your child will arrive late to school (after 8:50am):

· Phone the school office 4089 5111 to advise reason and expected time of arrival

Note: Your child <u>must</u> present to the office prior to going to the classroom to receive a late slip which will be given to the teacher on arrival to class.

Parents to ensure the safety of your children please make certain **they and the office** understand afterschool pick up arrangements.

Parent Pick Up is located under A Block on Main Street. Supervised until 3:20pm.

If existing arrangements do change please ring the school office 4089 5111,

before 2:00pm, so the message can be relayed to your child in plenty of time.

Please phone the school office or email admin@tolgass.eq.edu.au any changes to your contact details. This includes home address, email address and IMPORTANTLY your contact home phone/work phone and mobile number/s. Also advise any changes for those listed as emergency contacts for your child/ren.




The BPOINT




DOES YOUR CHILD'S THERAPIST OR HEALTH PROFESSIONAL REQUEST INFORMATION FROM TOLGA STATE SCHOOL?



Collaboration between parents, students, health professionals and education specialists are an important factor towards educational decision making and therapeutic interventions. Schools are often asked to share information about a students' functioning, needs and progress. Given the sensitive nature of these requests, schools must adhere to strict administrative quidelines.

STEP 3



STEP 4

Quality assurance is of top priority when conducting any assessments or reporting. You may be contacted by school personnel to gather more information. Often a draft is created, checked by students support team members and classroom teachers, then passed onto the request provider.

STEP 1

Make a request for information to the principal, admin@tolgass.eq.edu.au, and discuss your needs with your child's classroom teacher. This will ensure the right personnel are utilised to give the correct information to your chosen health professional.

STEP 2

Sign a 'Third Party Consent' document. This document ensures that the school, and health professional are not breaching any privacy laws.

STEP 5

If you have any further questions, or would like a more detailed document, please contact the Student Suppot Team at Tolga State School.




