- Reading groups systematic reading/literacy groups scheduled throughout school
- Opportunities for peer observation around reading/literacy groups in classrooms
- Professional Development opportunities for teachers and teacher aides with Reading in the classroom.
- · Response to Intervention System regular analysis and intervention response to students who are tracking below grade targets
- Inquiry cycle to be used to respond to reading data (with time to learn how to do as part of the classroom data cycle) identifying issues to support reading
